

American stock indexes grow slowly during Monday trading session. FRS meetings and U.S. 10-Year Bond yield fluctuations are in focus this week.

As at 8:30 p.m. (MSK), S&P500 index traded around zero, Dow Jones grew slowly by 0.1%, and NASDAQ technology index gained 0.3%.

U.S. Treasuries yield lost more than 2 percentage points today, declining to about 1.6% as at 8:15 p.m. (MSK). However, that was not the key driver for the market today.
